Alberta Housing Market Update

The Alberta sales in May decreased 6.1% yearly to 6,456 as the overall market continues to trend towards balanced market conditions. Months of inventory for the province was flat at 3.0.

In Calgary, May sales had a yearly decline of 14.0%, however, the average price climbed 5.0%. For the third month in a row the sales-to-new listings ratio was 55%, indicating stability in the market. Edmonton's yearly sales declined 4.6% as the average price continued to climb 5.0% yearly to \$441,215.

The provincial unemployment rate increased to 7.4%. The most significant decreases were in Transportation & Warehousing (-6,900), Finance, Insurance, Real Estate & Leasing (-5,100), Public Administration (-4,500). The most significant increases in employment were in Agriculture (+6,900), Information, Culture & Recreation (+6,500), and Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services (+4,300). Monthly full-time employment decreased by 1,800 jobs, while monthly part-time employment increased by 100 jobs; overall employment decreased by 1,700 jobs.
