Atlantic Housing Market Update

Despite trade-related economic uncertainty affecting household decisions, relative affordability and ongoing housing demand continue to drive residential investment in the region. Migration, declining mortgage rates, and rising incomes are bolstering housing starts in key cities across the Maritimes. Over the past year, MLS home price appreciation was strongest in the metro areas of Fredericton and Saint John in New Brunswick, and St. John's Newfoundland.

Sales to new listings ratios in New Brunswick (65%), Nova Scotia (63%), and PEI (61%) show strong sellers' market conditions while Newfoundland (59%) has dropped into a balanced market. All four provinces are experiencing less than 6 months of inventory well below their ten-year averages.

Unemployment in the Atlantic region grew in June to 7.7%, as 7,900 job losses were seen in both full-time (-600) and part-time (-7,300) positions. Losses primarily occurred in the manufacturing and finance sectors.
