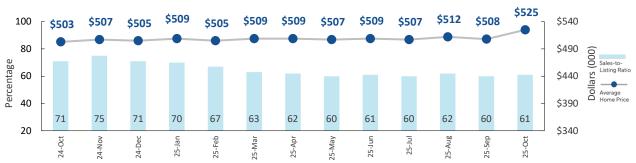
## **Alberta Housing Market Update**

Alberta sales in October decreased 11.1% year-over-year to 6,340. Months of inventory for the province has increased from 3.0 to 3.2.

In Calgary, October sales had a yearly decline of 12.3%. The yearly average price increased 4.0% to \$664,393 and the market remains balanced. Edmonton's yearly sales declined 15.9% as the average price climbed 3.2% yearly to \$450,922. The sales-to-new listings ratio indicates that the Edmonton market has moved more into balance.

The provincial unemployment rate was flat at 7.8%. The most significant decreases were in Educational Services (-11,600), Health Care & Social Services (-6,600), Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing (-3,000) The most significant increases were in trade (+12,700), Information, Culture and Recreation (+6,700), and Public Administration (+4,300). Monthly full-time employment decreased by 2,900 jobs, while monthly part-time employment increased by 13,300 jobs; overall employment increased by 10,300 jobs.
