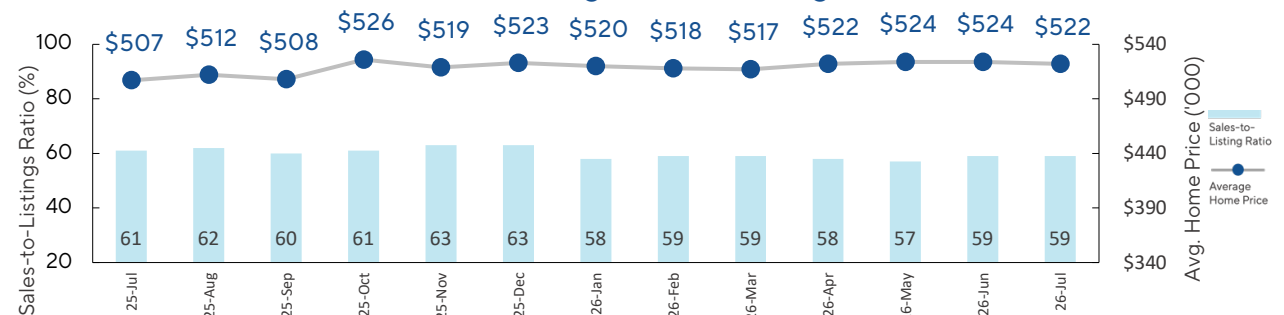
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Alberta's July sales declined 9.7% yearly. Balanced market conditions remain for the two major markets. Several of the smaller submarkets continue to favour sellers; however, Central Alberta has now moved into a balanced market. Months of inventory for the province was up slightly to 3.5 months.

In Calgary, sales declined 7.2% yearly with a modest uptick in average price of 2.0%. Edmonton's sales declined 10.7% yearly with an increase in average price of 2.2%.

The provincial unemployment rate was flat monthly at 7.0%. The largest decreases were in Accommodation and Food Services (-9,700), Business, Building & Other Support Services (-5,600), Professional, Scientific and Technical Services (-5,200). The most significant increases were in Construction (+7,600), Finance, Insurance, Real Estate and Leasing (+7,200), and Other Services (+4,400). Monthly full-time employment decreased by 8,500 jobs, while monthly part-time employment increased by 1,000 jobs; overall employment decreased by 7,300 jobs.
